

Paper Piecing: The Forest

Description Using **The Forest** pattern, learn basic techniques to paper piece and assemble blocks. This day-long workshop is designed for individuals with confident machine sewing skills but no or little paper-piecing experience. During the workshop you will practice paper-piecing, plan your own project, and start a full-size project (whether full-size or smaller wall-hanging) to complete on your own after the workshop.

Prerequisite Confident machine sewer with personal sewing machine in good working condition.

Learner Supplies

- sewing machine in good working condition
- at least two medium sewing machine needles
- thread (matching neutral color on spool and bobbin)
- stick pins and/or (optional) quilter clips
- (optional) cutting mat, minimum size: 24" x 36"
- (optional) rotary cutter, at least 35 mm blade in good condition
- Fabric for project (to be selected during the project for additional fee)*

Included in Workshop Fee

- ✓ fabric for practice blocks
- ✓ pattern
